Highlights

- Greenon Junior/Senior High School offered 11 College Credit Plus courses on campus, taught by credentialed Greenon educators.
- **Knights at Enon Primary School read more than 50,000 minutes during the school Read-a-thon in April.**
- Two Greenon grads in the Class of 2018 earned Associate's degrees with their high school diploma.
- **Indian Valley educators offered summer reading programs for students struggling to meet the 3rd Grade Guarantee. With the help of these dedicated teachers, 100 percent of our 3rd grade students were able to meet the requirements of the 3rd grade guarantee.**
- Greenon Junior High launched a positive behavior interventions and support program to improve social, emotional and academic behaviors.

Achievements

- At Indian Valley, 96 percent of our 3rd grade students met the requirements of the 3rd Grade Guarantee in August.
- Enon Primary students showed more than a year's growth during the school year on math and reading state assessments.
- Greenon families saved more than \$125,000 in future college tuition as students earned more than 830 college credit hours through College Credit Plus.
- Fifty-seven percent of Greenon students who took the AP European History exam passed the test to earn college credit. The test is often considered one of the most difficult AP exams.



Facilities

Thanks to the generous support of our community, a new K-12 school is under way at the site of Indian Valley School, with ground breaking on September 26, 2018.

Since May 2017, the district has been involved in a rigorous planning process designed to ensure that the new building meets the educational needs of students in this community for years to come.

The district is working with architect SHP Leading Design and construction Manager Summit Construction/Resource International.

The design process included tours of other schools, community and staff planning sessions, and several community meetings. A 3D walkthrough of the new facility was unveiled Aug. 29, 2018, at a community meeting.
